A special meeting of the Salida City Council was held this date in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Mayor Danny M. Knight.

ROLL CALL -

Present at roll call were Mayor Danny M. Knight, Council Members, Jim McCormick, Jay Moore, Tom Yerkey, and Hugh Young. Also present were City Administrator Steve Golnar, , and City Clerk Janella Martinez,.

Absent were Council Member Michael Delcavo, and Nancy McAninch. Also absent were City Attorney Jerald Devitt, and City Treasurer Christine Sturgeon.

PUBLIC HEARING –

1. Request for a Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License by High Country Hoagies, LLC dba High Country Hoagies 142 W. Hwy 50, Salida, CO 81201.

High Country Hoagies LLC dba High Country Hoagies, 142 W. Hwy 50, Salida, CO has submitted an application for a Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License to sell Malt, Vinous & Spirituous Liquor for consumption on the premises. A licensed restaurant may serve only to its own customers. It must actually and regularly serve meals and the sale of food must provide at least 25 percent of its gross income. Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m., if the restaurant is open and serving liquor, it must also be serving meals. If it remains open after 8:00 p.m. it must at least continue serving "light snacks and sandwiches".

After receipt of the application, the clerk then places it on the agenda of the local authority for a meeting. The application was presented to City Council at the April 16, 2007 City Council Meeting. The receipt will be considered April 16, 2007.

The next step is to set a Public Hearing date no less than 30 days after filing the application with the clerk. A Public Hearing was set for the May 25, 2007, City Council meeting.

It is also required to post and publish notice as provided in the statute. C.R.S. 12-47-311. The property was posted and public notice was published on Tuesday, April 25, 2007.

At the public hearing held pursuant to the notice, interested parties will be permitted to present evidence and to cross examine witnesses C.R.S. 12-47-311


Clerk Martinez told Council Members that due to the increased number of tables proposed in the outdoor area, an increase in occupancy was warranted by Building Inspector Harold Murray, who cited the need for an additional bathroom. If Council approves the license application, Martinez will send the signed approval to the State. The Colorado Department of Revenue, Liquor Enforcement Division will issue the State license and Clerk Martinez will hold the State license until the Certificate of Occupancy is issued by the building department. Following this procedure the State and the local license will be delivered to the applicant.

A motion was made by Young to approve the Hotel and Restaurant Liquor License application for High Country Hoagies, seconded by Yerkey. With all in consensus, the motion carried.


ADJOURNMENT-
