The base goal projection after weighting is as follows:

• Total Weighted DBE Availability: \$2,000

• Total for All Trades: \$1,340,158

Dividing the weighted DBE totals by the total estimate for all trades gives a base DBE availability figure for the projects anticipated during the goal-setting period. This figure is expressed as a percentage and serves as the basis for the three-year overall goal.

Base of DBE Goal: 0.1%

Not enough historical data on DBE participation is available to reference to make an adjustment to the Step 1 base figure; therefore, Harriet Alexander Field is adopting the Step 1 base figure of **0.1%** as the overall goal for this three-year goal period (FY 2024-26).

Breakout of Estimated "Race and Gender Neutral" (RN) and "Race and Gender Conscious" (RC) Participation

Harriet Alexander Field will meet the maximum feasible portion of the overall goal by using race neutral means of facilitating DBE participation.

- Arranging solicitations, times for the presentation of bids, quantities, specifications, and delivery schedules in ways that facilitates DBE, and other small businesses, participation;
- 2. Carrying out information and communications programs on contracting procedures and specific contract opportunities;
- 3. Ensuring distribution of DBE directory, through print and electronic means, to the widest feasible universe of potential prime contractors;

Harriet Alexander Field estimates that in meeting the established overall goal of 0.1%, it will obtain 0.0% from RN participation and 0.1% through race conscious measures.

This breakout is based on:

Only one project, the Taxiway 'A' Extension Phase I (Construction) project, is scheduled during FY 2024-26. The RN DBE participation is expected to be 0.0% of the overall goal due to the engineering portion of the Taxiway 'A' Extension Phase I (Construction) project being contracted through an on-call type contract. The entire DBE goal will then need to be

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accomplished through the construction portion of the project. To ensure that this Overall DBE participation is met through construction, the 0.1% goal will be achieved through RC measures.

Harriet Alexander Field does not have a history of DBE participation or over-achievement of goals to reference and expects to obtain its DBE participation through the use of DBE contract goals or a conscious effort to obtain DBE participation. Therefore, the entire goal of 0.1% is to be obtained through race-conscious participation.

Harriet Alexander Field will adjust the estimated breakout of race neutral and race conscious DBE participation as needed to reflect actual DBE participation (see §26.51(f)) and track and report race neutral and race conscious participation separately. For reporting purposes, RN DBE participation includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following: DBE participation through a prime contract obtained through customary competitive procurement procedures; DBE participation through a subcontract on a prime contract that does not carry a DBE goal, DBE participation on a prime contract exceeding a contract goal, and DBE participation through a subcontract from a prime contractor that did not consider a firm's DBE status in making the award.

Consultation

In establishing the overall goal, Harriet Alexander Field provided for consultation and publication. This process included consultation with minority, women's, and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the Harriet Alexander Field's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs. The consultation included a scheduled, direct, interactive exchange with as many interested stakeholders as possible focused on obtaining information relevant to the goal setting process, and was conducted before the goal methodology was submitted to the operating administration for review. Details of the consultation are as follows.

The consultation engaged in was a teleconference (via Microsoft Teams), which was held on January 18, 2024, at 10:00 am (MT).
