Salida, CO – The City of Salida is pleased to announce that Bill Almquist has been promoted to the position of Community Development Director. Almquist has worked for the City of Salida since November of 2018 as a Planner in the Community Development Department. During his time with the City, Almquist has helped shepherd a number of notable projects through the Planning Commission and City Council, and was also responsible for the City being awarded \$225,000 in grants for projects associated with mobility. Mr. Almquist holds a bachelor's degree in Public Policy Analysis from Pomona College and a master's degree in Community and Regional Planning from the University of Oregon.
